SCHOLARSHIP AWARD CRITERIA

Winifred Van Hagen/Rosalind Cassidy Scholarship Award

Awarded to the 2 highest ranked applicants

John F. Kennedy Scholarship Award

Awarded to the highest ranked undergraduate applicant

James Echols Scholarship Award

Awarded to the highest ranked minority applicant
(Asian, African American, Latino or Native American)

In order to qualify for one of these scholarships, an applicant must:

- Be a major in Health, Physical Education, Recreation or Dance
- Have completed (or be enrolled in) a minimum of 60 semester/90 quarter units of college work
- Be a resident of California and attend a California 2 or 4 year college/university
- Have a minimum 3.0 overall GPA
- Be a CAHPERD member for a minimum of 60 days prior to application.

Criteria for selection includes:

- Scholastic proficiency: Minimum 3.0 GPA required
- Leadership ability: In school, community, and professional activities
- Personal qualities: Enthusiasm, cooperativeness, high degree of individual responsibility, initiative, evidence of good personal relations, and the ability to work with others

Applicants must submit a completed application form, **three** letters of recommendation, and scholastic verification by the university registrar's office or transcripts of all college work.
